Village of Geneva on the Lake Regular Meeting of Council Minutes of Meeting 10/24/2022

Mayor Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:38 PM.

Fiscal Office Kimberly McKinley performed roll call and the following council members were present: Jennifer Allison, Matt Caudill, Cindee Dudeck, Gary Himes, PJ Macchia and Donald Woodward. Also present were Solicitor Cris Newcomb, Village Administrator Jeremy Shaffer, Deputy Administrator Jessi Spurlock, Police Chief Kyle Cawley and Fire Chief Chris Craft.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited; a moment of silence followed.

MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING: Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2022 regular council meeting. The motion passed with all in favor. Hearing no corrections, the minutes were approved as presented.

PERSONS APPEARING BEFORE COUNCIL: None

PAYMENT OF BILLS: Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to approve the payment of bills. The motion passed with all in favor.

Council reviewed reports from the Mayor for the month of September.

POLICE CHIEF REPORT: Police Chief Cawley provided a summary on his written report for the month of September. Eleven body armor vests have been received. Police department created a field training manual.

PUBLIC HEARING REPORT: A report on the meeting held on September 19, 2022 was provided.

FIRE REPORT: The department provided a written report on fire & ambulance calls, and hour statistics for the month of September. Frank Rosier has been promoted to Assistant Fire Chief and Any Kaschalk will serve as Captain.

GOLF REPORT: Report provided for month of September. League agreement and league pricing have been updated.

Deputy Administrator Jessi Spurlock provided an update on zoning code enforcement. McBride Consulting performed a site visit. Recommendations included standardizing zone map colors and renaming zones. Adding a residential/mix use zone was recommended. A Coastal Erosion Mitigation grant for planning and design was submitted and included Buckeye Beach, Jennie Munger Museum, Geneva Twp Park and Palmetto allotment.

ADMINISTRATORS REPORTS: Jeremy Shaffer provided a summary on his written report. Report included Lake Erie water levels, WWTP, Streets, Sanitation, Park, CIP including an update on the siphon project, Economic Development Reports. In addition, Village Administrator will serve as the designated flood plain administrator (DFPA). He would be responsible for approving floodplain permit applications. Adm will participate in online classes. Village was invited to submit a final OPWC application for Shadowbrook/Fairway culvert replacement.
