ORDINANCE 2022-103: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CURRENT PAY ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND REVISE THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GENEVA-ON-THE-LAKE, COUNTY OF ASHTABULA, AND STATE OF OHIO, REPEALING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to waive the three reading rule. The motion passed with all in favor. Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to pass Ordinance 2022-103. The motion passed with all in favor.

ORDINANCE 2022-104: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF GENEVA-ON-THE-LAKE POLICE DEPARTMENT ROSTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to pass as an emergency. The motion passed with all in favor. Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to waive the three reading rule. The motion passed with all in favor. Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to pass Ordinance 2022-104. The motion passed with all in favor.

Macchia made a motion, seconded by Allison to authorize Mayor Bennett in negotiating a lease agreement with ACCVB. The motion passed with all in favor. A formal resolution will be presented in January.
